## What is Tissue Sampling?

Tissue sampling is a process in which young crop plants are taken from the field and sent to a lab to be tested for nutrient uptake efficiency. By testing your crops, you can identify any possible nutrient deficiencies in the crop and possibly find a nutrient blend that can be applied foliar to the crop to correct the problem before it robs yield. Tissue sampling is a key component in the quest for 300 bushel



## Is Tissue Sampling for Me?

Tissue sampling can be of benefit for just about any grower. After nutrients are spread onto the field they are commonly forgot about and assumed to be working for the crop. A tissue test can confirm whether or not the nutrients applied were adequate for the demands of the crop. Knowledge is power so give yourself the power to take on high yield challenges.
